Your Sylvania Fire Fighters spent the day at Central Elementary School for the first day of Safety Town. Over 130 children were given lessons today for fire safety. Subjects covered how to call 911 for an emergency, what to do if the smoke detector sounds, safety around matches and lighters, know 2 ways out of your home, work with your parents to develop a home fire escape plan - and practice it, and finish at a planned meeting place. Also covered was, if there is smoke in your home, crawl low under the smoke and once you are out of your home, stay out and how to Stop, Drop & Roll if your clothes catch fire. The children had a good time spraying water from the fire hose and practicing escaping from the smoke from the fire safety house.
